DETAILS: Our pastor and church have been extremely supportive and helpful. We are using the facility, including access to Zoom. We used a sign-up sheet for snacks, which has been very helpful to have everyone pitching in.

We have had approximately 18 different families come, with about 10 of those families regularly committed. So about 35 people have seen most of the content. Only about 4 of the families are church members.
